

COMPETITION RULES

All payouts will be determined by the Executive Board.

~~SUMMER MEDAL TOURNAMENT: updated in 2007~~ Discontinued Spring 2014

~~In order to be eligible for the summer medal tournament, members must have paid their dues by their first round of Men's Club and have an established handicap by the start of the tournament, which will begin on the sixth Wednesday of Men's Club and run for 9 consecutive weeks. Summer medal is where you count your best five nine hole rounds out of nine played, full handicap to apply. Summer medal must be played with another Men's Club member. You do not need to declare your round as playing Summer medal. Your official Men's Club round is the one you use for Summer Medal. The tournament committee will post any additional rules.~~

CLUB HANDICAP TOURNAMENT:

In order to be eligible for the Club handicap tournament, members must have paid their dues by their first round of Men's Club. They must have an established handicap a week prior to the posting date of the tournament, which will begin on the third Wednesday of Men's Club. Handicap between players will be figured at full difference. All matches should be played as 18-hole matches. However, by mutual agreement of player's involved, 9-hole matches will be considered legal. If players cannot agree on a 9-hole match then the match must be played as an 18-hole match. Handicap strokes will apply to sudden death playoffs. Any matches not posted by the due date will be DQ'ed with both players getting the losers amount for that match. The tournament committee will post any additional rules.

SENIORS HANDICAP TOURNAMENT: Updated 9/5/2012

Seniors will not have a flighted tournament. Instead, they will play in their own handicap tournament. All matches played in this tournament must be played from the gold tees. Any senior has the option of playing down into the flighted tournament but then must play from the white tees.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP & FLIGHTED MATCH TOURNAMENT: Updated 9/5/2012

In order to be eligible for the Club championship tournament, members must have paid their dues by their first round of Men's club. They must have an established handicap as of the posting date of the tournament, which will begin on the ninth Wednesday of Men's Club. Club championship will be played in flights. Any Member has the option to play down into the championship flight. The Executive Board shall determine how to divide the flights as evenly as possible. All matches will be played scratch. All matches should be played as 18-hole matches. However, by mutual agreement of the players involved, 9-hole matches will be considered legal except for the final matches, which must be 18-hole matches. The championship flight must adhere to a 36-hole final match. If players cannot agree on a 9-hole match, then the match must be played as an 18-hole match. The tournament committee will post any additional rules.

HORSERACE TOURNAMENTS (3 & 4 MAN): Revised 9/4/2013

All horserace players must be Men's Club members. They all must have an established handicap. Seniors must deduct 1 ½ strokes from their gold tee handicaps if playing from the gold tees. Players can only play on one team per round. This tournament will start at noon on the first day & end at dusk on the final day. The same team can only get paid once. Points are scored according to your score. You get 5 points for eagle or better, 3 pts. for a birdie, 2 pts. for a par, 1 pt. for a bogie and no points for a double or higher. You then add up those points along with your nine hole handicap to come up with your total score. All players' scores count toward the total score. Current handicaps at the time of each race should be used. There are no refunds for a rain out for this tournament.

~~4MAN3NET RACE: Discontinued 9/4/2013~~

~~All players must be Men's Club members. They all must have an established handicap. Seniors must deduct 1 ½ strokes from their gold tee handicaps if playing from the gold tees. Players can only play on one team per round. This tournament will start at noon and end at dusk. The payout is the same as the Horserace. There are 3 or 4 players on a team. You take the 3 best net scores per hole to obtain your score. To arrive at your final score take the number that you are under par and put this at the bottom of the card. In the case of an official rain out, all monies already paid will be returned.~~

HANDICAP RULES FOR ALL COMPETITION:

Your current handicap at the time of your round/match should be used.

You must have an official handicap to play in any competition which includes the syndicates.

A trend handicap is not an official handicap and cannot be used.

TOURNAMENT DIVISION AND PAYOUTS: (Updated 9/5/2012)

The Executive Board shall determine how to divide up the flighted tournament.

The pay-outs for each flight will also be determined by the Executive Board.

Non-played money rounds in any of the Men's Club tournaments will be paid out equally what the loser of that round was to receive.

CURRENT PAYOUTS: Updated 2/26/2014

Handicap Tourney \$1,200 – 1st \$320, 2nd \$200, 2-3rd \$100, 4-4th \$60, 8-5th \$30

Flighted Tourney \$1,200 - Divided equally among all players. Paid down to 4 spots, 40%, 30%, 15%, 15%, if more than 11 players in a flight. 11 or less payout goes to 60% 1st and 40% 2nd.

Horsrace Tourney Divide up 100% that is collected. 1st 40%, 2nd 25%, 3rd 20, 4th 10%, 5th 5%.
